Subject: PLEASE DO NOT WEAR STREET SHOES ON POOL DECK

KAC Families,

I just talked with the manager at the pool and **it is imperative that you DO NOT wear street shoes and/or boots on the pool deck at any time.** State law is very strict on this issue and the pool can be shut down if an inspector visits at a time when someone has shoes on deck or they witness debris from street shoes. If you have a pair of shoes that you utilize only on the pool deck, as the coaches do, that is OK. However, these shoes must have never been on surfaces outside of the pool.

I know I personally have violated this rule due to ignorance of the issue. I have worn clean tennis shoes on the deck that I carried in to the pool. However, these shoes had been worn outside on other occasions. Even though I cleaned them prior to wearing them on deck, this is still a violation of the rules. I will not do that again.....

Again, it is imperative that we observe the no shoes on deck rule. The pool manager will have to restrict access to non-coaches to the balcony if we cannot find a way to stop ALL street shoes from entering the pool deck. Obviously, we do not want to have to take this step. We ask for your help in observing the very important rule.
