Subject: KAC Concession Stand Donations

Hello KAC Parents,

My name is Dan Johnson and I am the chair person for concessions at KAC. Last year we had a very successful year at the concession stand and we hope to do so again this year. Like last year, we are asking the families of KAC to help support the club with donations to the concession stand. If my memory is correct, last year we only had to ask for donations one time and that was enough to sustain us throughout the entire season. I know that this time of year it seems like everyone is asking for something but we really cannot do this without you. That is why we work to keep this to a one-time request.

We have most of the paper supplies we will need. What we don't have, we will purchase. What we need is the food and beverages to sell. I have broken the list of families roughly in half. If your last name begins with the letters **A-J**, you are asked to donate the beverages. If your last name begins with the letters **K-Z**, you are asked to donate the snacks items (a suggestion list is below).

Beverages -

Because of the school's contract with Coke, we will need to stick to Coke products. We cannot sell any other soft drink products. We can and will sell water and Gatorade along with the Coke products. If your last name is in this group, please donate either water, Gatorade or Coke products (Coke, Diet Coke, Sprite etc). If donating Coke products, please make sure you donate 12z cans, if water, please donate the full size bottles and if Gatorade you can do either size bottle and we will price accordingly.

Snacks -

You can donate whatever you think would sell well. Candy bars, granola bars, small bags of chips, cookies, crackers, anything that is wrapped and can be sold as some sort of a snack. Most of the items will sell for \$1.00. If you are getting candy bars etc, please have them be regular size. Minis will be too hard to sell and the king size would cost too much for a concession stand. Try not to get something that has a short shelf life as we will carry over anything that doesn't sell to the following home meets.

We will also be selling donuts, hot dogs, some fruit, coffee, nachos and some other items. These are items the club will take care of getting.

Please begin to bring your donations to practice now. We have the KAC Rock the Blocks Invitational on December 12 so the time is now. You can give your donation to anyone on the parent committee and we will put it away for the meets.
